Summary of Position

Organizational Relationships

1. Reports to: Public Works Director
2. Directs: This is a nonsupervisory.
3. Other: Works with the general public and other City employees, and performs janitorial and maintenance services. Must be 18 years old to operate equipment necessary to perform job.

Essential Duties

-) Performs routine janitorial cleaning, and minor repairs at park areas and other City-owned facilities and properties.
-) Performs other related duties as requested, directed, or assigned.

Job Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

-) Familiarity with City and OSHA safety requirements.
-) Knowledge of SDS for each chemical used.
-) Knowledge of proper safety equipment when performing tasks.
-) Use of power tools.
-) Knowledge and understanding of the proper use of the following equipment: weed eater, push mower, hedge trimmer, and chain saw.
