Summary of Position

Performs semi-skilled maintenance of City's facilities and grounds and provides landscaping services.

Organizational Relationships

1. Reports to: Maintenance Superintendent
2. Directs: This is a nonsupervisory position.
3. Other: Works with the general public and other City employees, and performs landscaping and maintenance services. Must be 18 years old to operate equipment necessary to perform job.

Essential Duties

-) Performs routine maintenance, including cleaning, mowing, and weed eating at park areas and other City-owned facilities and properties.
-) Performs setup and take down for special events.
-) Performs other related duties as requested, directed, or assigned.

Job Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

-) Familiarity with City and OSHA safety requirements.
-) Knowledge of MSDS for each chemical used.
-) Use of proper safety equipment when performing tasks.
-) Knowledge of the proper use of the following equipment: weed eater, riding lawn mower, push mower, hedge trimmer, and chain saw.
-) Ability to operate safely necessary equipment, including weed eaters, lawn mowers, hedge trimmers, and chain saws.
-) Ability to back up trailers and drive water truck.
-) Ability to use and/or wear all required personal protective equipment.
-) Ability to work in adverse weather conditions, exposed to outside elements and disagreeable materials.
-) Must possess current valid Arizona Driver's License when hired.
