### REHABILITATE/RECONSTRUCT APRONS; PARALLEL TAXIWAY 'A'; PCC FUEL PAD

#### NOTICE TO BIDDERS

The City of Williams, Arizona will receive bids for the above-mentioned airport improvements at H. A. Clark Memorial Field. Sealed bids will be received by either mail or hand-delivery to the City of Williams, Office of the City Clerk, 113 S. 1<sup>st</sup> Street, Williams, Arizona 86046, until **2:30 P.M. MST, July 31, 2019**. Any bid received after the hour of closing time will be returned unopened. At the bid opening time, bids will be opened and read aloud.

The airport improvements include:

- Reconstruction of Fueling Aprons Approximately 4,300 SY
- Rehabilitation of the Hangar Aprons Approximately 20,600 SY
- Rehabilitation of the Terminal Apron Approximately 11,725 SY
- Rehabilitation of the Taxiway 'A' Approximately 40,040 SY
- Construction of PCC fuel pad Approximately 178 SY
- Rehabilitation of the Taxiway 'A' Approximately 28,200 SY

The work will include pavement reconstruction, crack seal/repair, application of surface treatments, installation of three taxiway edge lights, and installation of pavement markings.

A Pre-Bid conference will be held at 11:00 AM MST, July 16, 2019, at the airport terminal located at 3501 N. Airport Road, Williams, AZ 86046.

Bidding Documents may be viewed at the City of Williams Administrative offices located at 113 S. 1<sup>st</sup> Street, Williams Arizona, 86046. The Proposal must be made on the forms provided in the Contract Documents.

This Project includes funding from the Federal Airport Improvement Program (AIP) and as such, requires compliance with the Federal Provisions detailed within Division 3 of the Specifications. Furthermore, the following provisions are listed below including their references:

Buy American Preference, (Reference: 49 USC § 50101)  
Foreign Trade Restriction,  
Davis-Bacon Requirements,  
Affirmative Action Requirement,  
Government Wide Debarment and Suspension,  
Government Wide Requirements for Drug-Free Workplace Act of 1988.

A bid guaranty in the form of either a certified or a cashier's check made payable to the City of Williams, Arizona or in the form of a surety (bid) bond for not less than ten percent of the amount of the bid, shall accompany the proposal. Surety (bid) bonds will be accepted only from corporate sureties. The successful bidder will be required to furnish both a Performance Bond and a Labor and Materials Bond in the amount of one-hundred percent (100%) of the contract.

In addition, until the award of a contract is made, the City of Williams reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities and informalities therein if such waiver is deemed to be in the best interest of the City, and is in conformance with applicable state and local laws or regulations pertaining to the letting of construction contracts; advertise for new proposals; or proceed with the work otherwise. All such actions shall promote the City's best interests.
